



IN PENNSYLVANIA THERE ARE:

- Approximately 14,000 children in foster care
- There are nearly 3,000 children waiting to be adopted
- Approximately 1,100 who will age out of the system this year with no forever family



OF THOSE WHO AGE OUT

80% of the boys will be in jail
before two years

70% of the girls will be pregnant
and single before they reach age
21



- Approximately 50% of foster families quit before their first year.
- Nearly 90% quit before two years



CARE COMMUNITIES

If a foster family has a care community, then nearly 90% are fostering beyond two years.
