While this position involves working with various digital platforms and equipment, we have clear and comprehensive documentation to guide you through each step. We currently livestream our services to both YouTube and Facebook, ensuring our online audience receives a high-quality and engaging experience.

This role involves both pre- and post-service responsibilities, along with active monitoring during the service to maintain a seamless livestream.

Schedule

At present, I'm primarily handling this role, but I'm looking to train one or two additional team members who are interested in learning and serving in this capacity. Volunteers are expected to arrive by **9:00 AM on Sunday mornings** and stay a few minutes after the service concludes to properly end the stream and complete post-service procedures.

Training

If you're interested in joining the livestream team, I'll provide hands-on training over the course of **two consecutive Sundays**.

- **Week 1:** You'll shadow me during the setup and service, observe the process, and review the documentation.
- **Week 2:** You'll take the lead on setup and execution with my supervision to ensure everything runs smoothly and to address any questions in real time.
