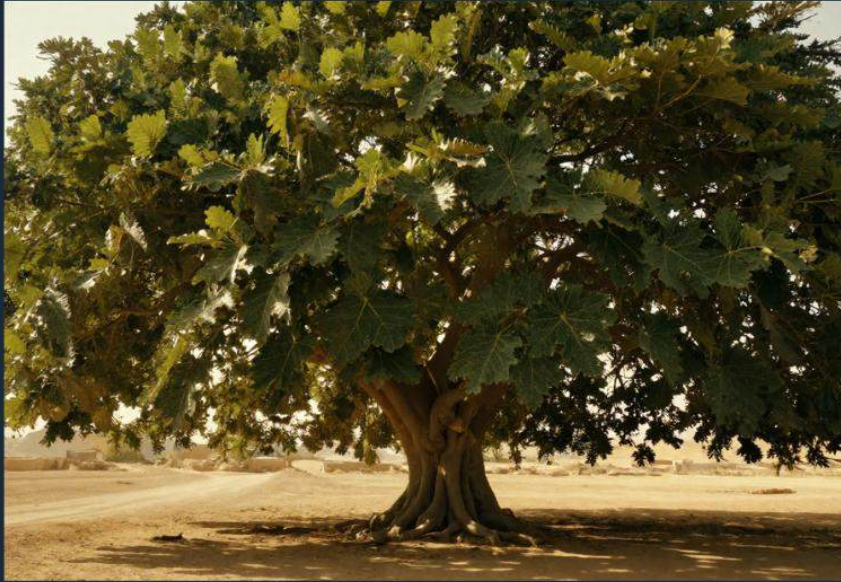

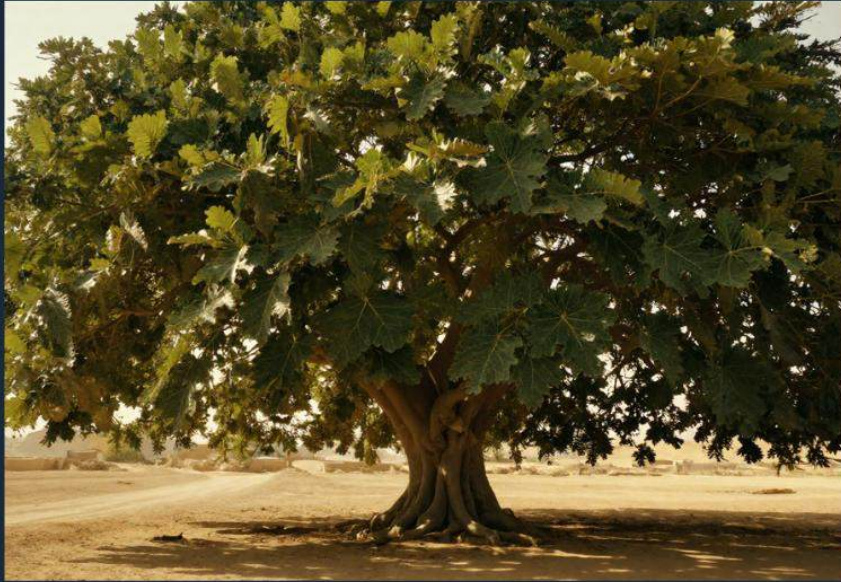

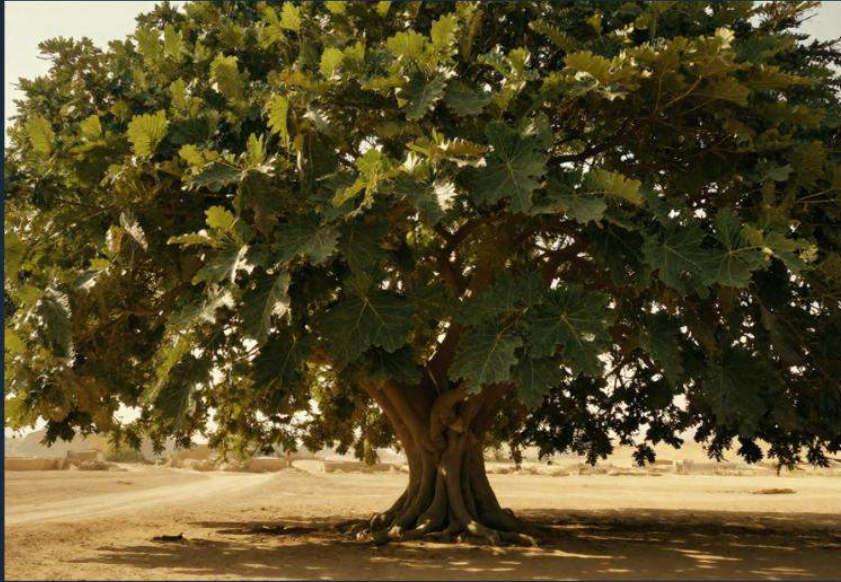
²⁰ As they were passing by

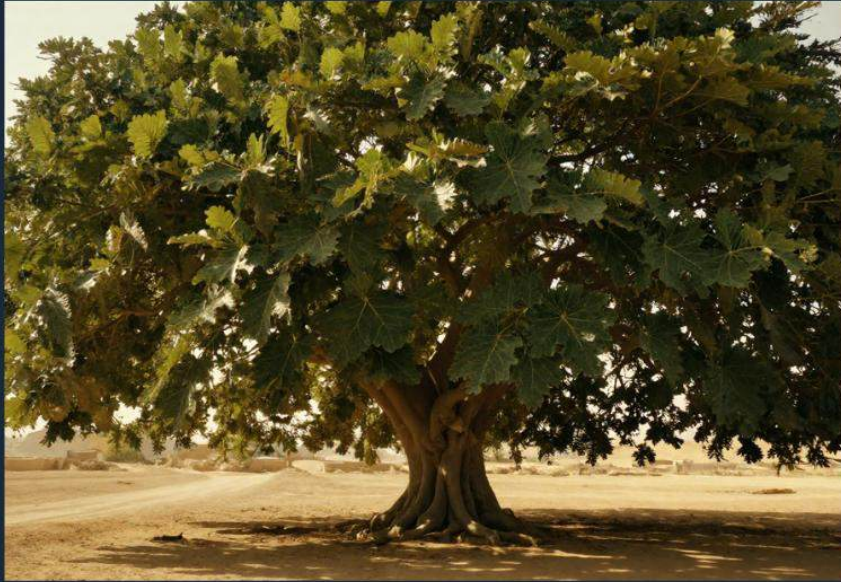

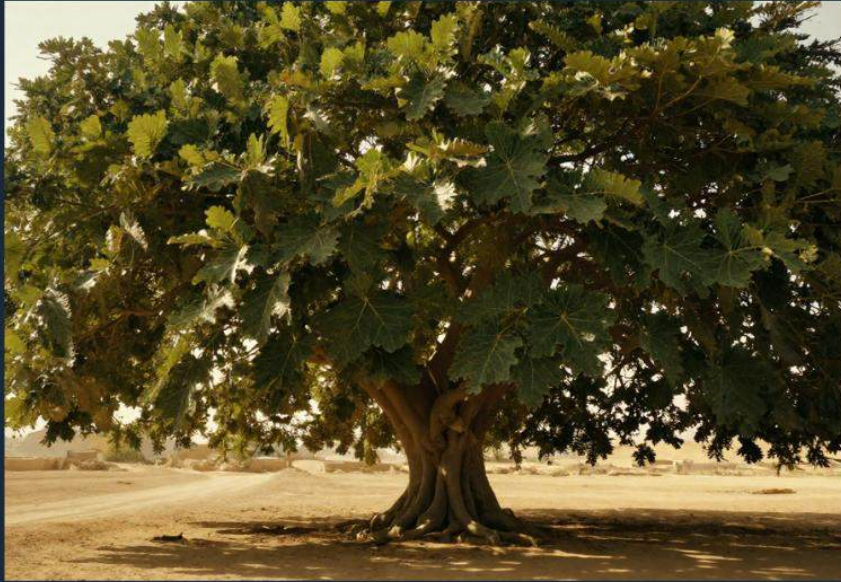
²⁴Therefore, I say to you, all things for which you pray and ask, believe that you have received them, and they will be granted to you.

²⁰ The disciples were amazed when they "saw" this and asked, "How did the fig tree wither so quickly?"

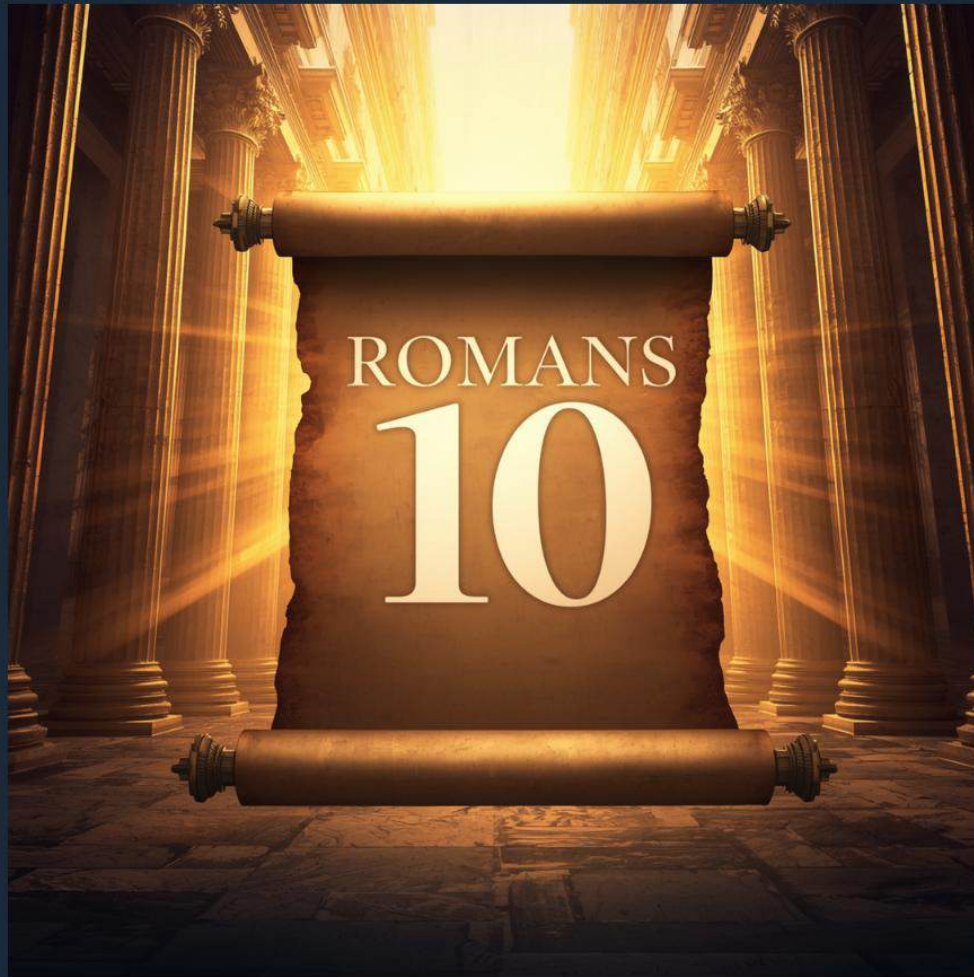

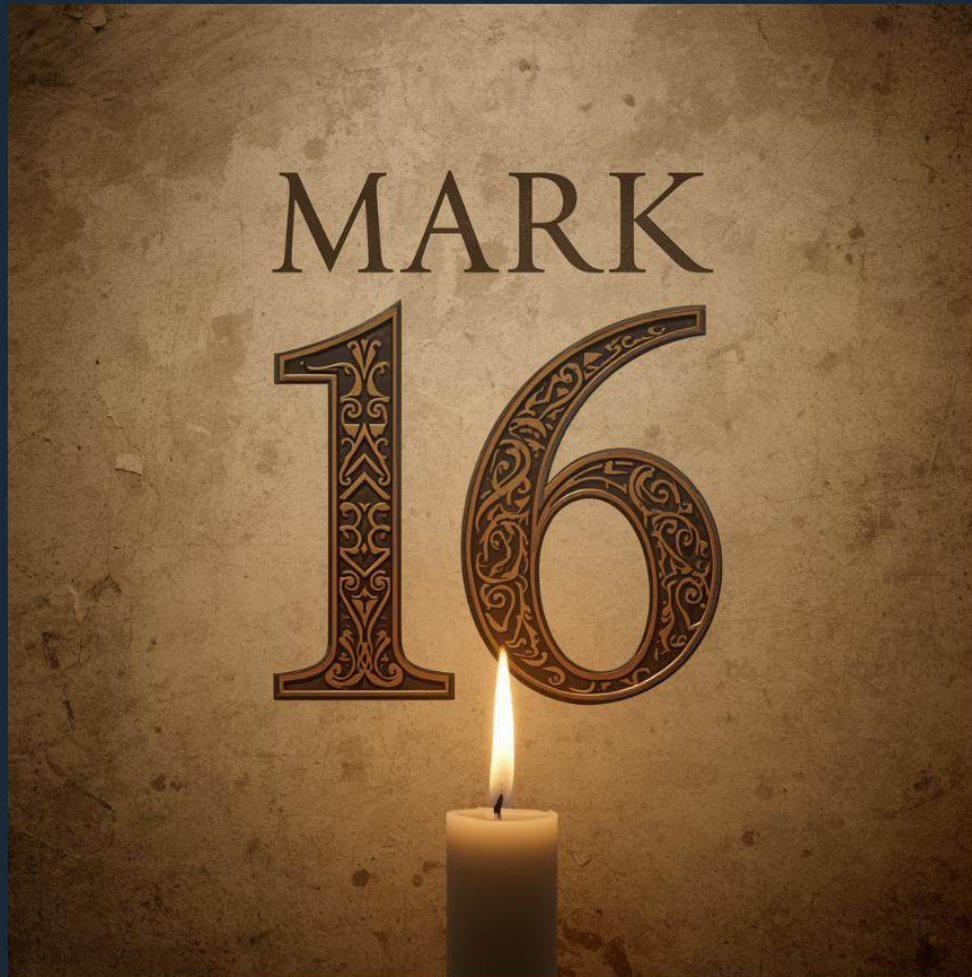
¹³ For “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”



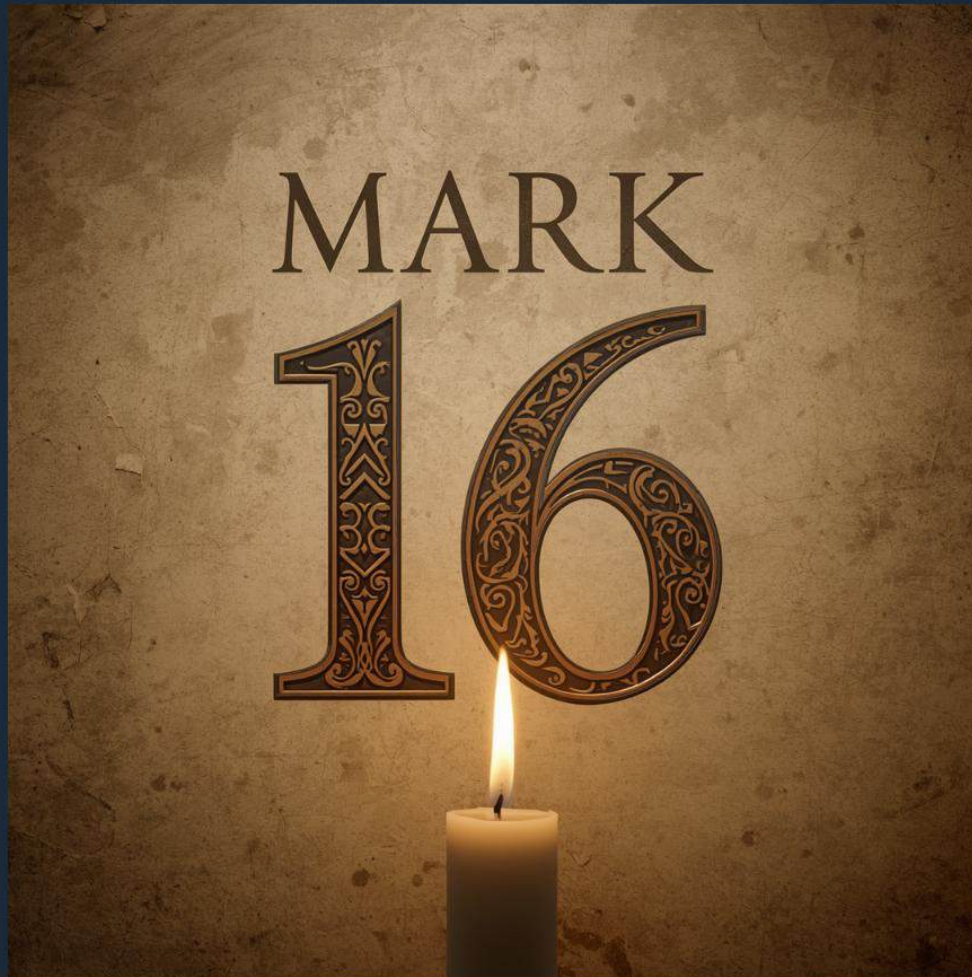
¹⁴ But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?



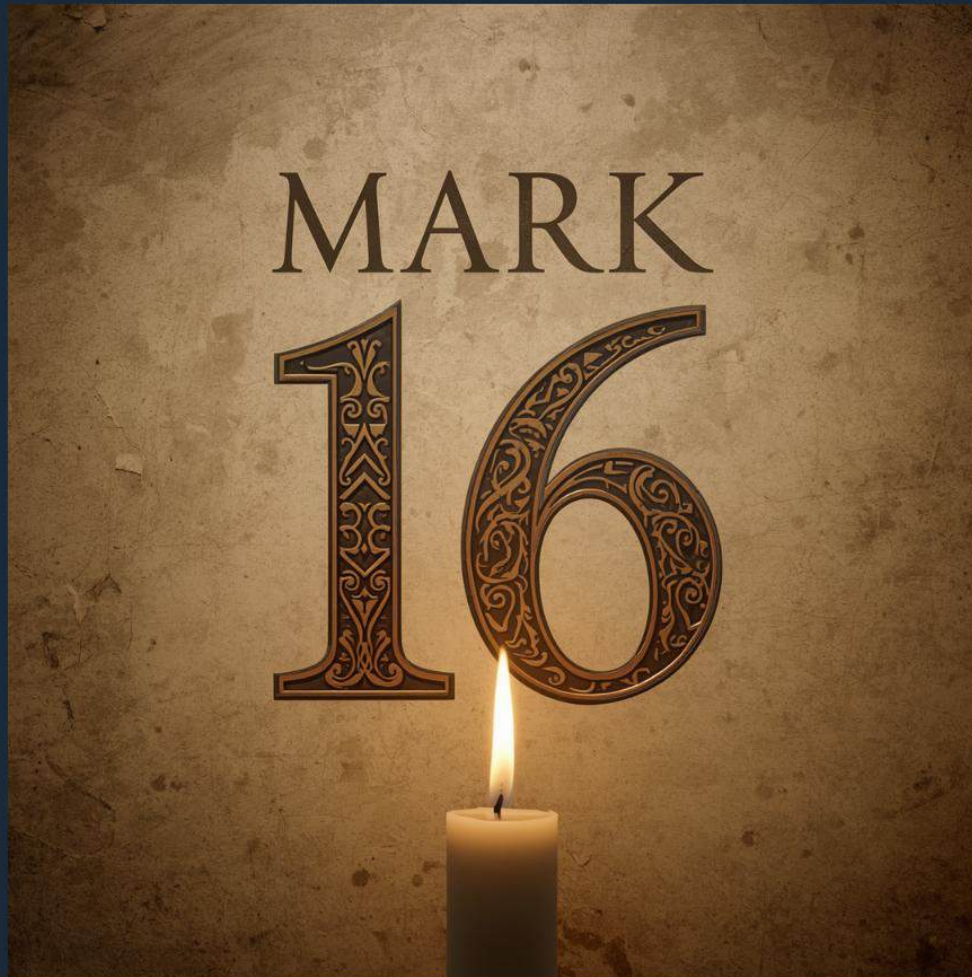
¹⁵ And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, "How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!"



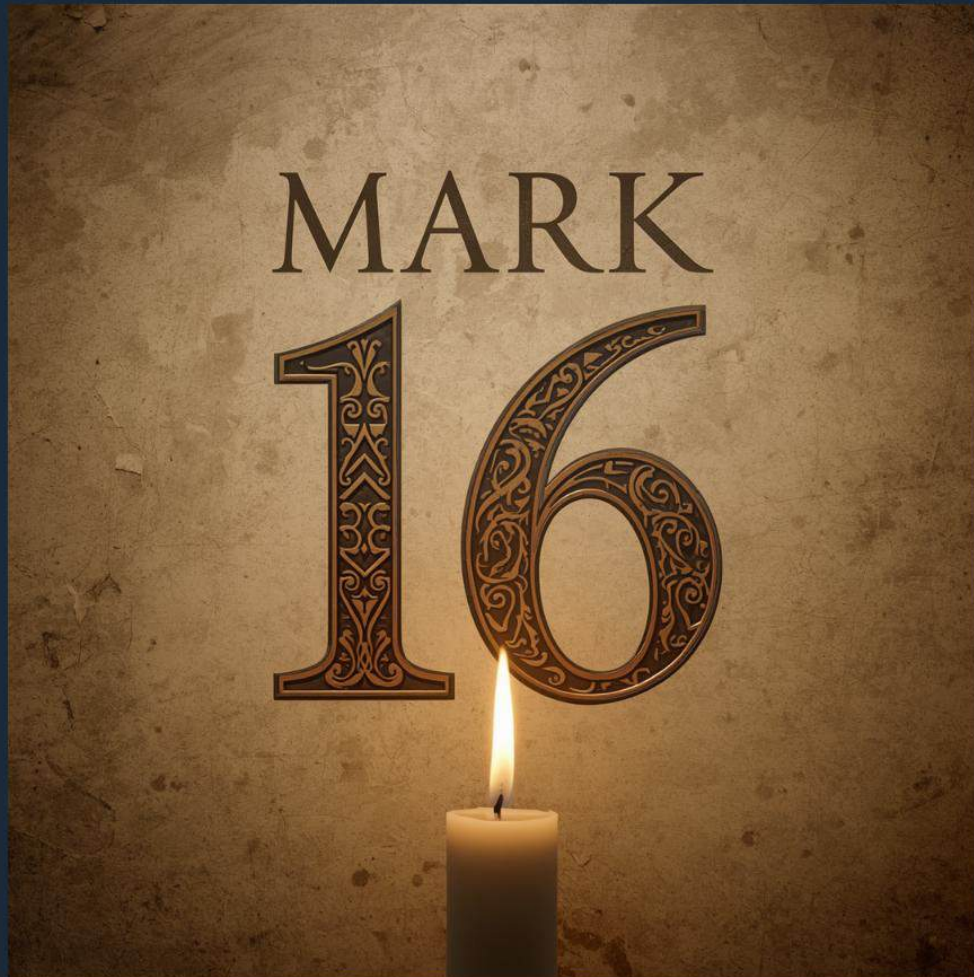

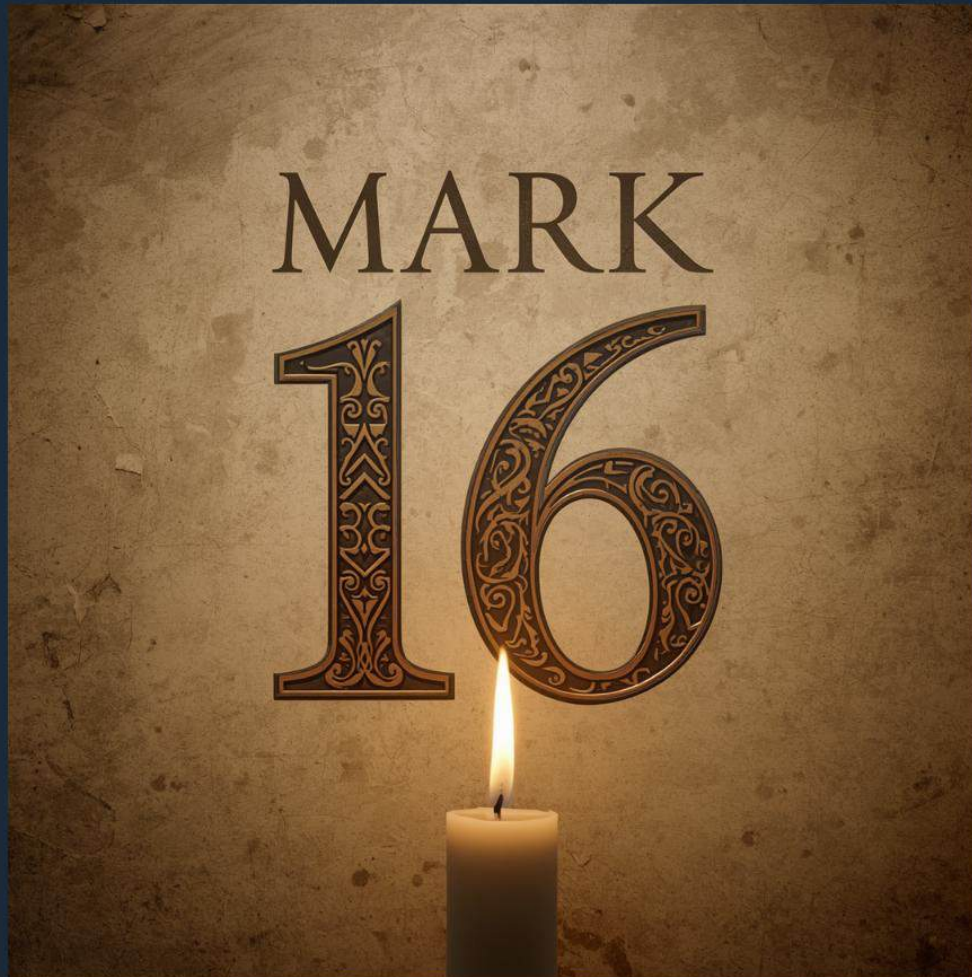

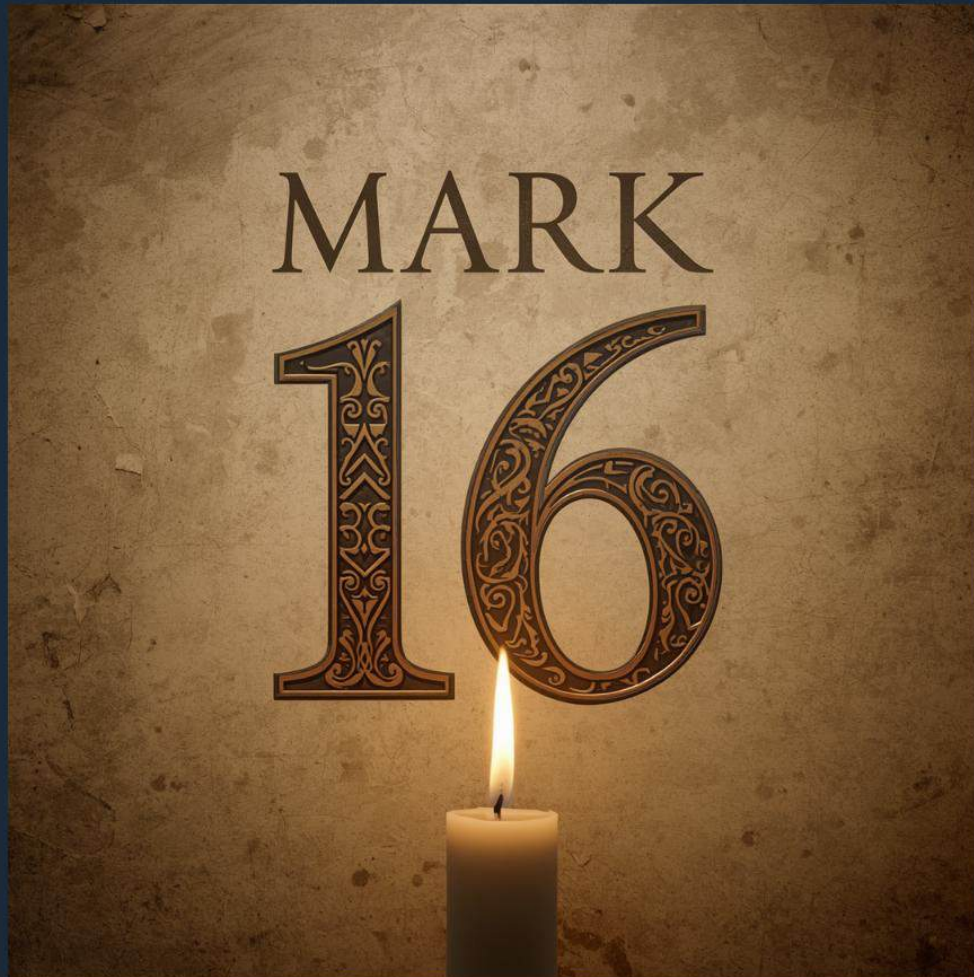
¹⁷ These miraculous signs will accompany those who believe: They will cast out demons in my name, and they will speak in new languages.



¹⁸They will be able to handle snakes with safety, and if they drink anything poisonous, it won't hurt them. They will be able to place their hands on the sick, and they will be healed."



¹⁹ When the Lord Jesus had finished talking with them, he was taken up into heaven and sat down in the place of honor at God's right hand.



²⁰ And the disciples went everywhere and preached, and the Lord worked through them, confirming what they said by many miraculous signs.



Doubting Thomas



²⁴ *One of the twelve disciples, Thomas (nicknamed the Twin), was not with the others when Jesus came.*



²⁵ They told him, “We have seen the Lord!” But he replied, “I won’t believe it unless I see the nail wounds in his hands, put my fingers into them, and place my hand into the wound in his side.”



²⁶ Eight days later the disciples were together again, and this time Thomas was with them. The doors were locked; but suddenly, as before, Jesus was standing among them. "Peace be with you," he said.

look at my hands. Put your
hand into the wound in my
side. Don’t be faithless any

The Acts of the Holy Spirit

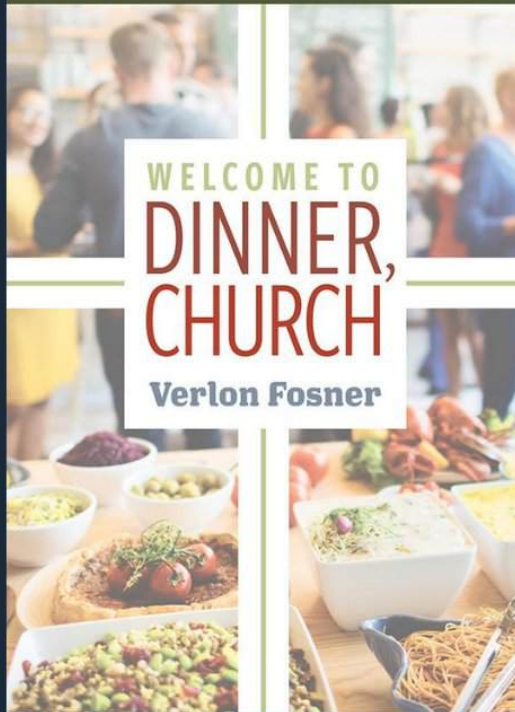
