6. The disciples could not follow him until a later date.



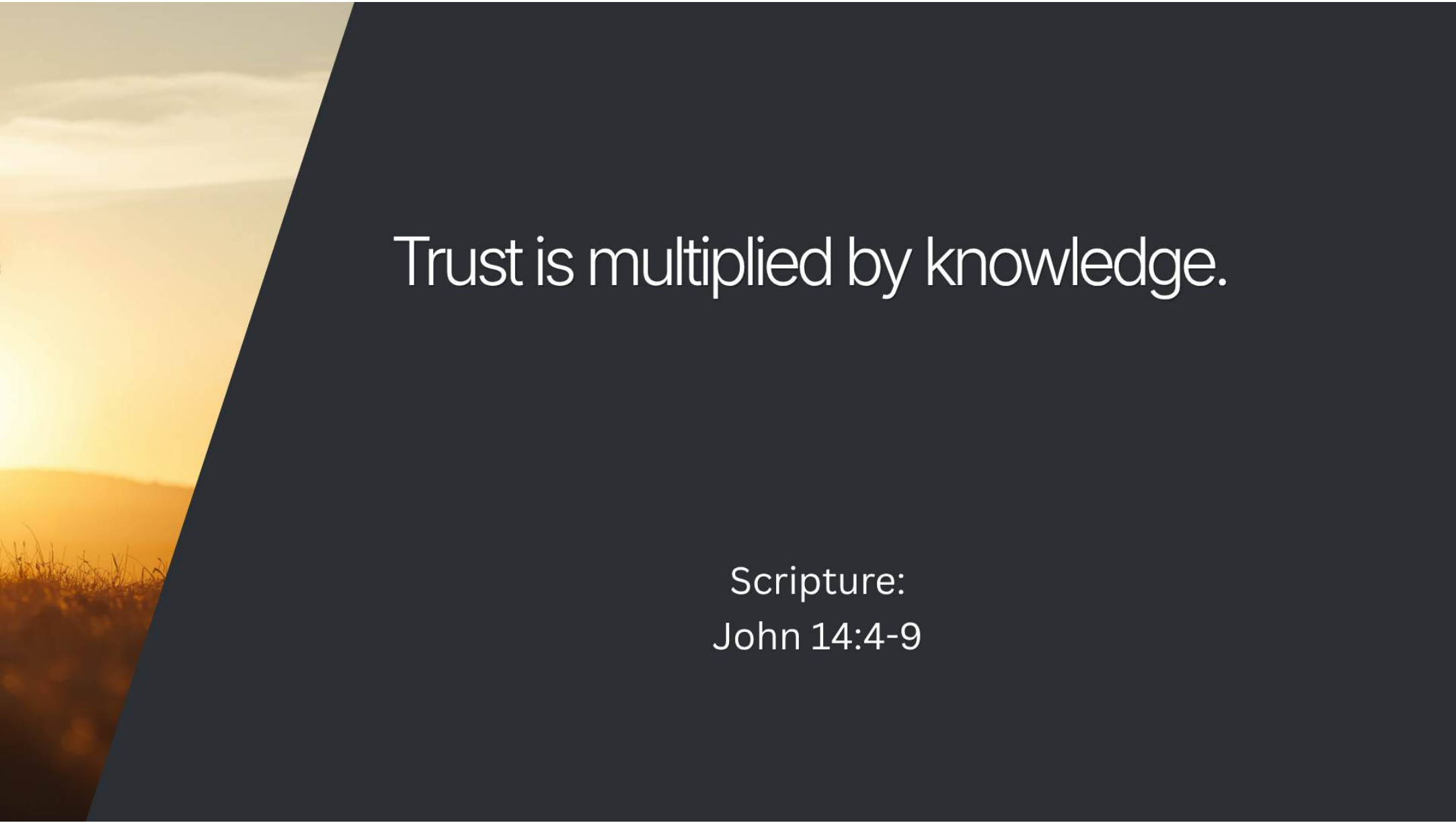

"Trust" is the belief that someone or something is reliable, truthful, and competent. Trust is built over time through consistent behavior and actions that prove one's trustworthiness.

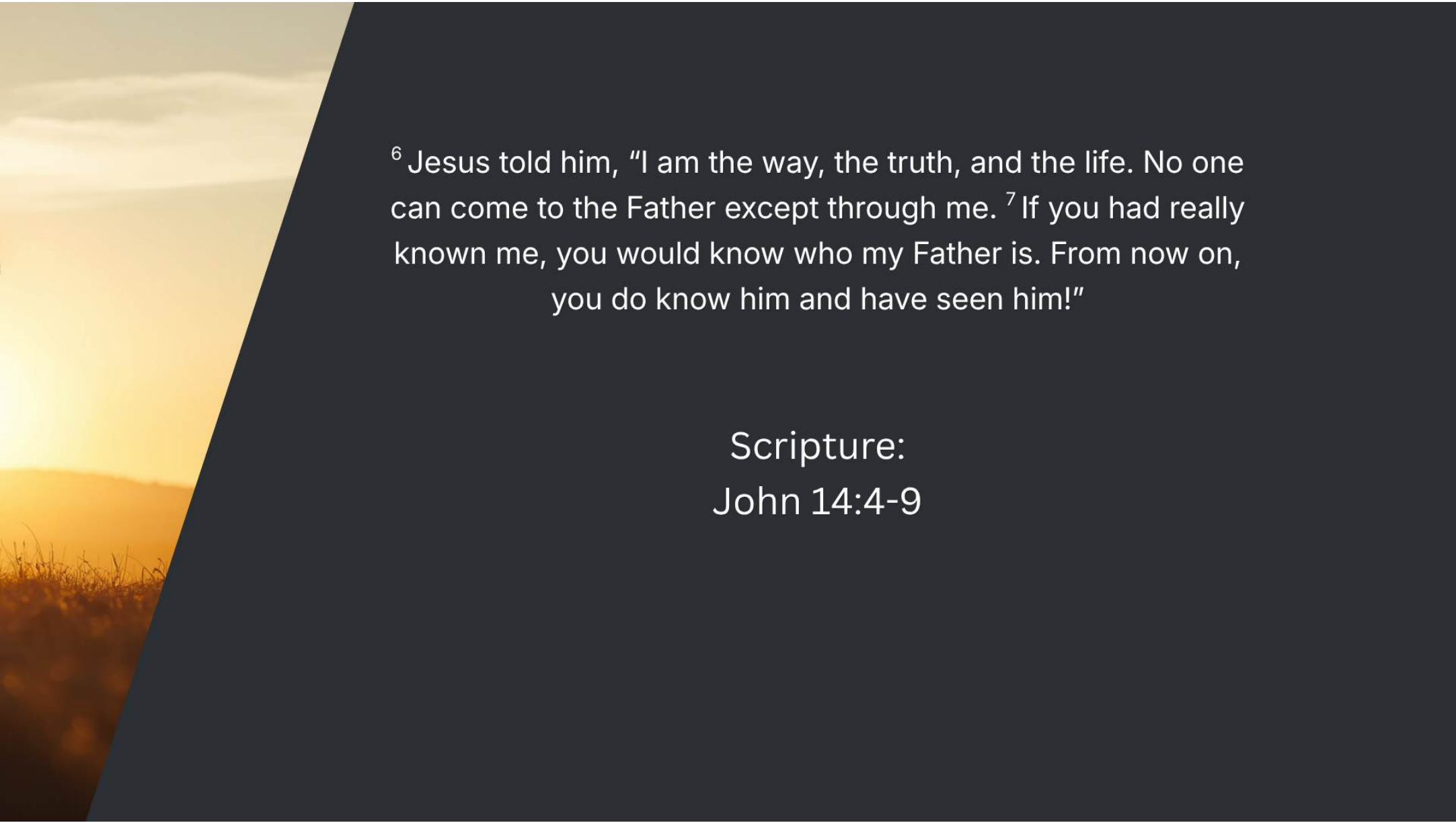
Trust

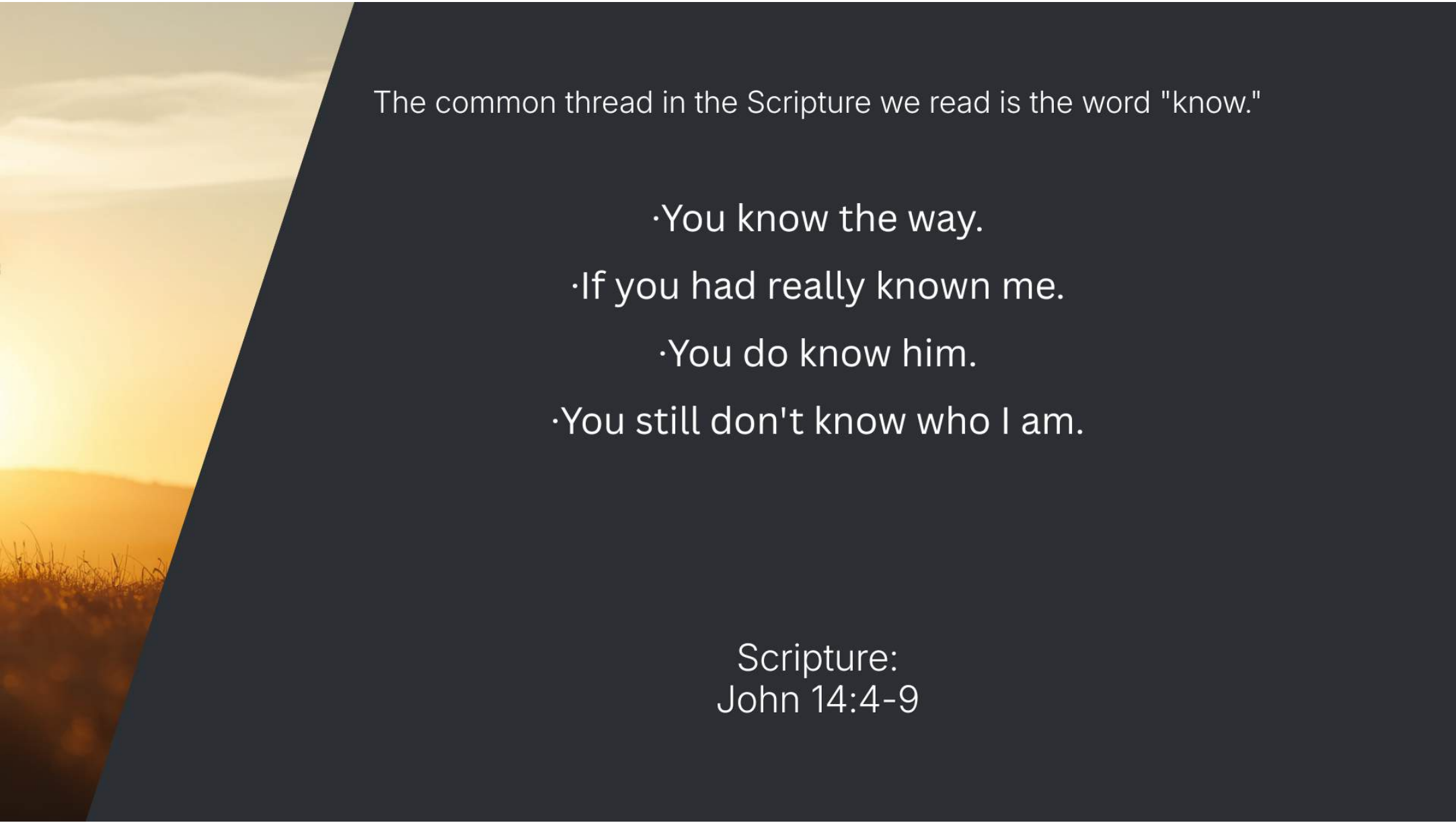

The common thread in the Scripture we read is the word "know."

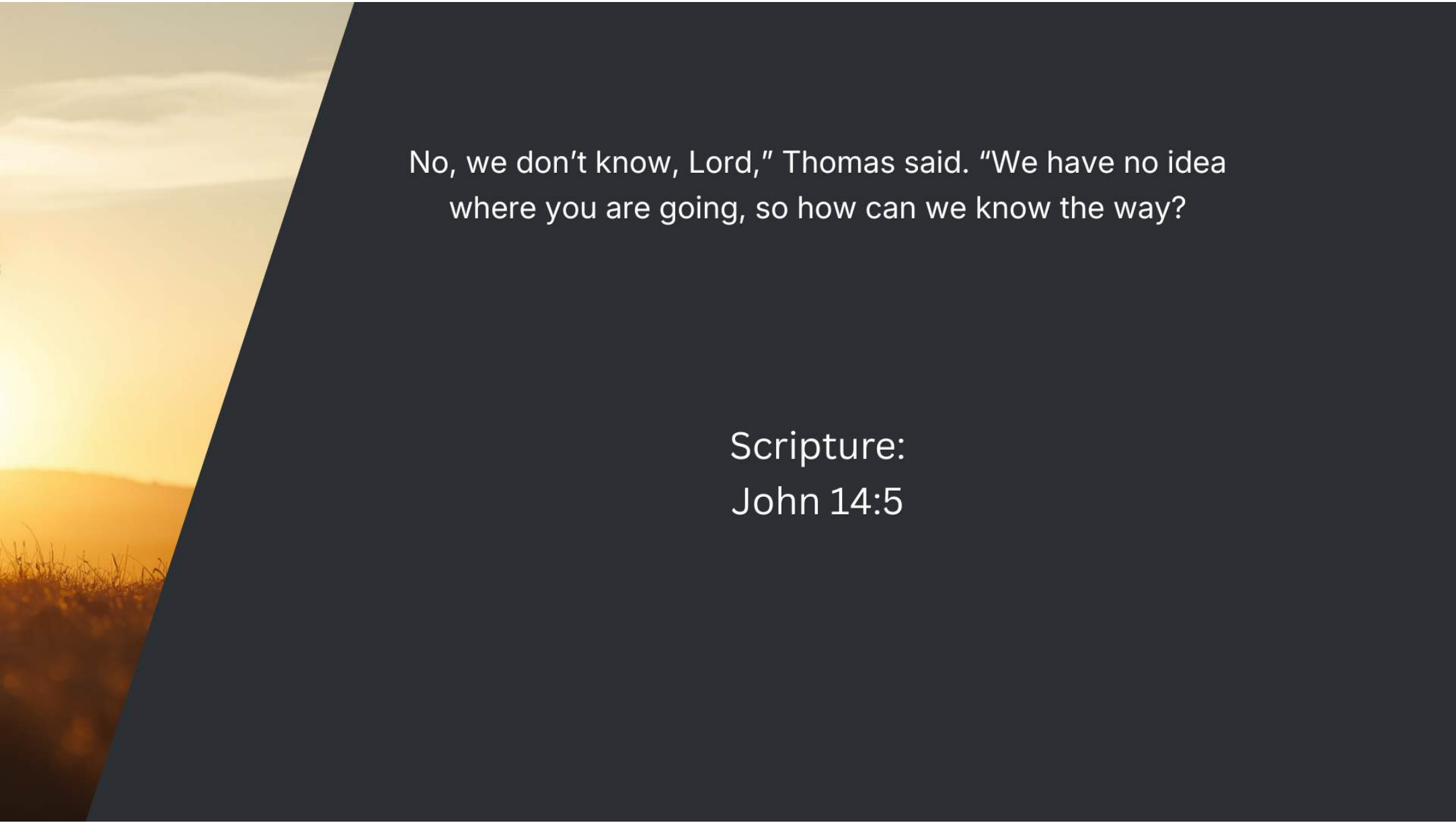

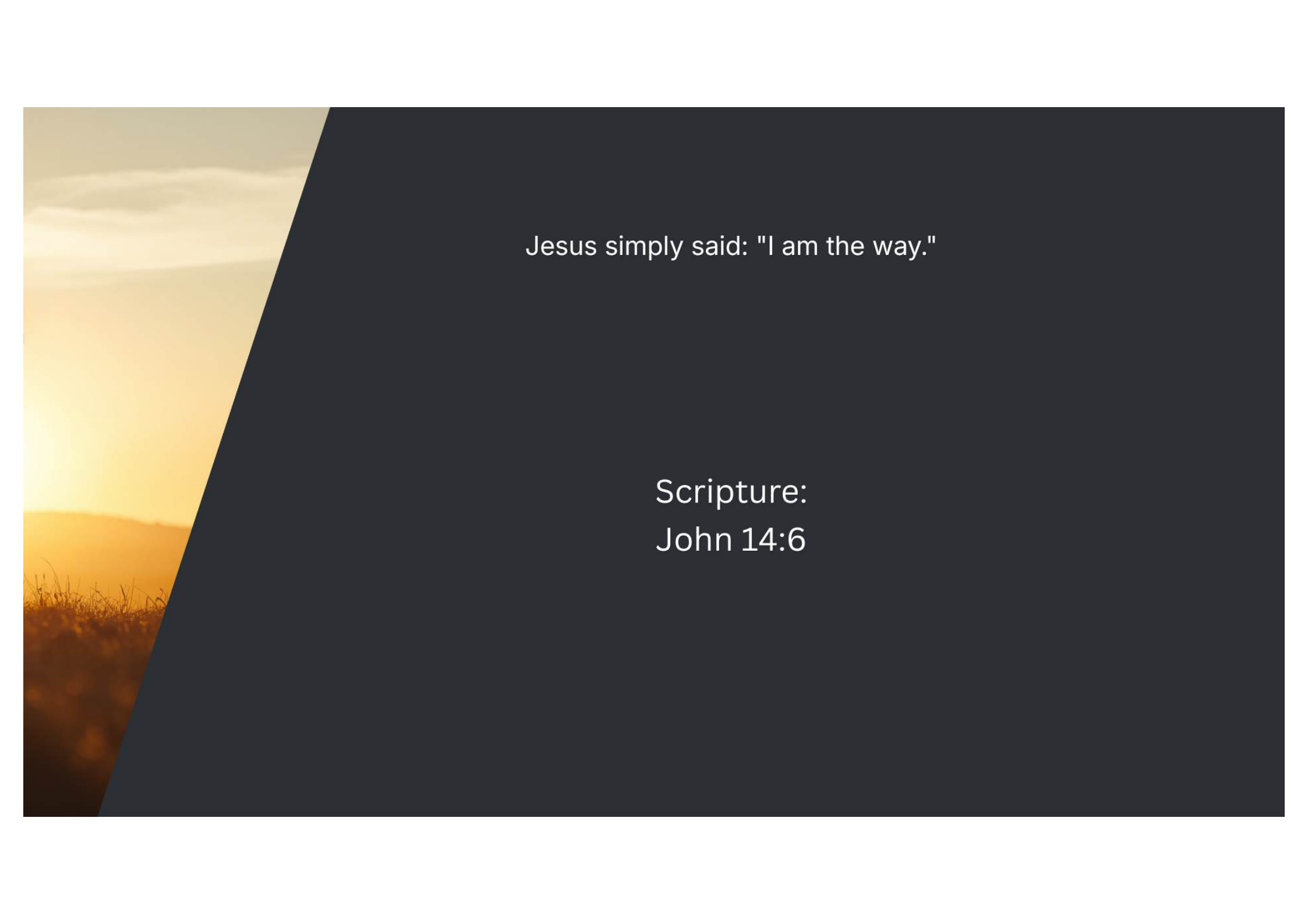

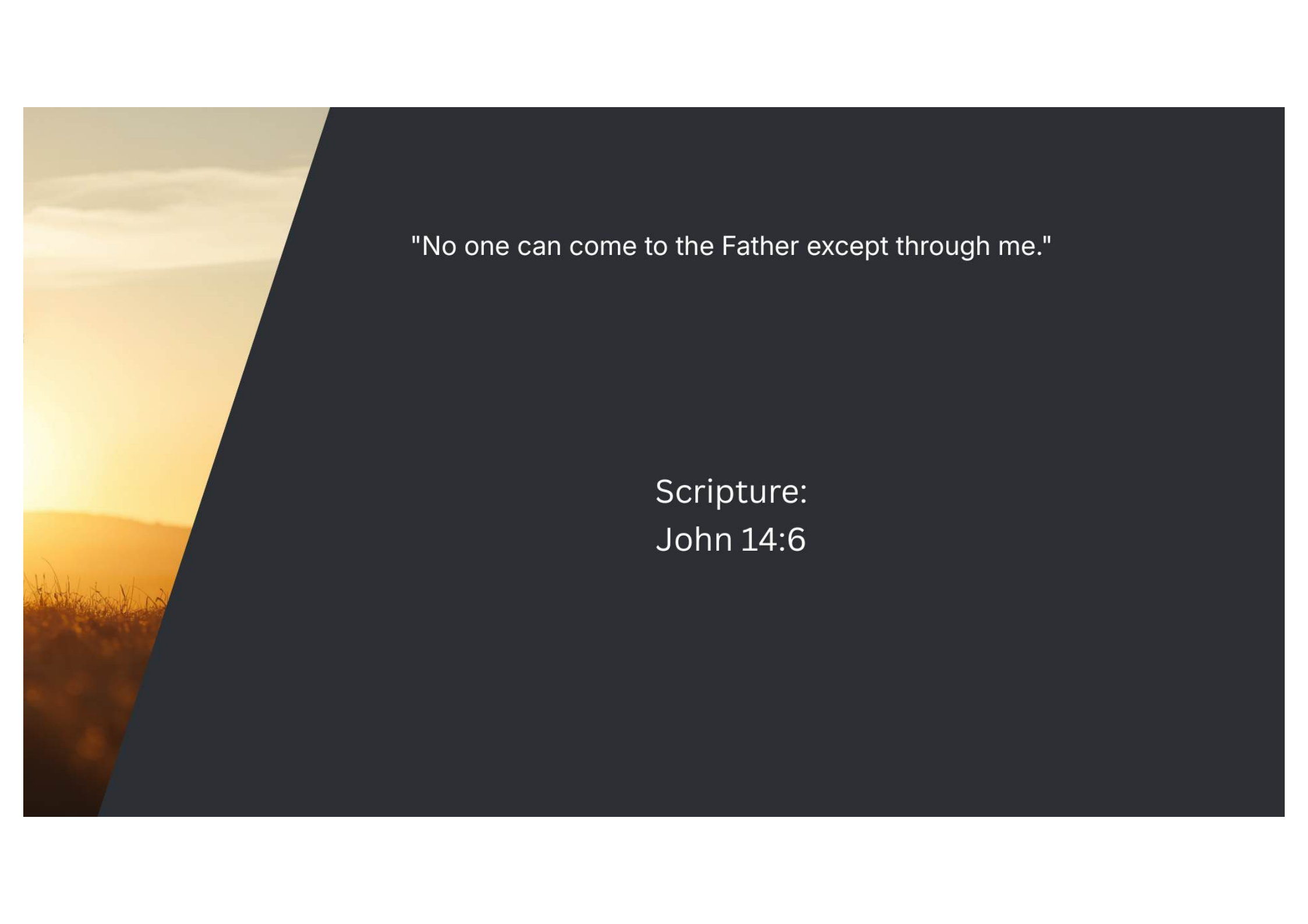
